



Healthy Hens and More Eggs




#### Minimum Space: 4 Square Feet per Hen



#### **Ventilation: Air is Necessary**




## **Protection in the Winter: Not Windy and Not Wet**






In the garden, chickens love to eat your tomatoes and lettuce.




In the garden, chickens do not like corn, beans or potatoes




Compartmented trough, offering grits, shell, mash, grain, and greens.
